[2] Registration and Participation Fee

Please access the conference site scheduled to open on December 1st and follow the steps below to pre-register and pay the participation fee.

Registration and payment of the participation fee will be closed on March 18th (Friday).

- 1) First, create your personal account at the entrance of the conference site (setting login ID and login password). The login ID at this time is your e-mail address, and the login password can be decided arbitrarily. When you enter your ID and password, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to you automatically. Click the link in the e-mail to complete the account creation process.
- 2) Once you have created your personal account, you will be able to enter the conference site using your login ID and login password.
- 3) Please pre-register from the "Registration Page" on the conference site. At this time, you can choose credit card or bank transfer (postal transfer) as a payment method of a participation fee.
 - i) If you choose to pay by credit card:
You will be notified by an e-mail that registration has been completed, and you will be able to browse the "Program" page immediately.
 - ii) If you choose bank transfer:
You will be notified by an e-mail of the bank transfer acceptance. After this, please complete your bank transfer (or postal transfer) procedure. After the confirmation of the payment by the secretariat, we will make it possible for you to browse the "Program" page. It will take several days during this time, so please transfer as soon as possible.
