Kyushu University is seeking an experienced individual with expertise in teaching and research for appointment as an associate professor in the Laboratory of Quantitative Food Economic Analysis, Division of Agricultural and Resource Economics, Department of Agricultural and Resource Economics, Faculty of Agriculture.

The Laboratory of Quantitative Food Economic Analysis constitutes Division of Agricultural and Resource Economics along with the other four laboratories (Food and Agricultural Policies, Agricultural and Farm Management, Food Marketing and Distribution, and Environmental Economics).

The division deals with education and research on socio-economic issues of international food system from comprehensive social sciences in order to contribute the stable supply of safe foods supported by domestic and foreign food industries, the sustainable and environmentally-friendly development of regional socio-economies.
