Bylaws to the Copyright Regulations

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 6, Paragraph 1 of the Copyright Regulations of The Agricultural Economics Society of Japan, these Bylaws hereby stipulate the terms and conditions under which an author shall be permitted to utilize their own work, published in the "Journal of Agricultural Economics" (『農業経済研究』), the "Japanese Journal of Agricultural Economics" (formerly The Japanese Journal of Rural Economics), or the "AESJ Research Papers" (『日本農業経済学会論文集』), (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Society's Journals"), without requiring prior authorization from the President of the Society.

- 1. Utilization by the author for the submission of a doctoral dissertation.
- Utilization for the purpose of public dissemination via the internet of the author's
 doctoral dissertation by the degree-granting institution. Provided, however, that in the
 event a doctoral dissertation containing a work published in the Society's Journals is
 to be commercially published, prior authorization from the Society shall be required.
- Deposit in an institutional repository maintained by the author's affiliated institution.
 Provided, however, that such deposit shall be limited to the author's final manuscript subsequent to peer review (post-print). Authorization from the President of the Society shall be required for the deposit of the published version of record into an institutional repository.

In all instances of such utilization, the source must be explicitly attributed.

Furthermore, the provisions set forth herein shall have retroactive effect from the date of any amendment to these Bylaws.

Supplementary Provisions

- 1. These Bylaws shall enter into force on April 1, 2010.
- 2. Any amendment to these Bylaws shall be executed by the Editorial Board, and, following approval by the Board of Directors, shall be publicly notified in the Society's journal, on the Society's official website, or through other comparable media.

Supplementary Provisions

- 1. These Bylaws shall enter into force on March 12, 2024.
- 2. The designated point of submission shall be posted on the Society's official website.

Supplementary Provisions

- 1. These Bylaws shall enter into force on March 11, 2025.
- Any amendment to these Bylaws shall be executed by the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors, and, following approval by the Board of Directors, shall be publicly notified in the Society's journal, on the Society's official website, or through other comparable media.
